Announcement

We now have a new set of validation rules that is referred to as a collection cycle called "Ed-Fi 3.1 Non MARSS". Within that set of validation rules contains only validations for district's AEO data. Currently, when districts run their MARSS WES edits using Ed-Fi as a data source (only for districts in production), those edits contain all the necessary checks and balances needed for the MARSS collection cycle. In time, those edits will move over to the EDVP and will be launched as a set of validations within a collection cycle.
